| Mobile Outreach Teams | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How to provide access to basic social services at local level that should be accessible to everyone regardless of the nature of their impairment or the required level of support; • How to enable identification of particular vulnerable groups that are “invisible” to the institutional system and public services and to improve understanding of the needs of the local community; • How to ensure community-based service delivery in order to lessen the burden of the family, in many cases women, in their role as caretakers; • How to establish and run mobile outreach teams; • Portfolio of services of mobile outreach teams. |
