



DECLARATION

We, Mayors and elected representatives of the local and regional governments of South-East Europe, meeting tagether in Rijeks on the occasion of the Second HEXPO International Fair organised by NALAS and partners, have agreed upon the following Declaration:

Our region's European Future

 We re-affirm our commitment to our common European mission and future, which we expressed as follows, at the first NEXPO, held in Sarajevo in 2011:

> "The countries and peoples of south-East Europe need to take their proper place, very soon, within the European Union. This will mark another major step towards unifying our continent, and thereby enhancing our common goals of peace, stability and sustainable prosperity."

- 2. We greatly welcome the fact that the Republic of Croatia, on 1st May 2013, became the 28th Member State of the European Union, and amongst NALAS's membership joins Bulgaria, Romania and Storewisa within the EU. We also welcome the European Council's recent decision to open accession negotiations with Setub. We look forward to continuing progress with other states. We further welcome the signing of Association Agreement in November 2013 with Moldova and Utraine. We also hope for prompt resumption of discussions with Turker on the acquite communities.
- 3. We emphasize that closer integration of all within our region with the U is and remains a priority for all of u, whilt recogniting the different starting points and stages reached to date. EU integration for our region is essential for both for ensuring paces and stability for the long-term, and for achieving transport encounts, cost and environment all devolupment for our popels. In short we need to remove the barriers to integration and unlock our potential.
- 4. This is not just a matter for national governments and the EU institutions. It requires in particular the commitment of local governments, with their local communities, to the objectives of closer integration, as well as their capacity, through better governance, to deliver results on the ground.



Cost and Finance Model for Solid Waste Management

Tool for Solid Waste Management developed and tested in 4 municipalities (Duboko SCTM; Herceg Novi, UoM, Zavidovici, SOGFBiH, and Soldanesti, CALM).

Cost and Finance Model is a web-based spreadsheet application available on NALAS web pages.

Complements with other Task Force products: Solid Waste Information System and Guide + Landfill Management

Bases for future e-Course

5 LGAs: CALM, SOGFBiH, UoM, SCTM and UORH carried out **dissemination events** and collected feedback from 129 municipalities

105 municipalities have expressed motivation to further use of the tool

Monitoring of municipal waste collection and transportation current costs

Nine Quick Response requests in 2013

SOGFBIH: Information on local economic development

CALM: Personal Income Tax collection




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


Revenue Structure 2013






Revenue Structure: Projects in 2013




