










Number of Refugees who **Transit** or **temporarily Settle** in the Municipality



basis for municipal responsibility to assist refugees




Municipal response (actions) to the refugee crisis



municipal needs to better cope with the refugee crisis

- Equipment and infrastructure for Water Supply and Water Sanitation at the refugee temporary shelter site
 - Drinking water supply line, vehicle for cleaning sewerage systems, reconstruction of collection well
 - Water supply system, well (new water source at the sight), sanitation system
- Equipment and infrastructure for Solid Waste
 Management at the site of refugee temporary shelter
 - Truck for SW collection, containers/bins, tractor, bulldozer




the role of the LGAs in supporting the affected municipalities

- to assist municipalities and provide expert support,
- to provide support in the international arena and become active in the promotion of activities which are already carried out

Financial support


Food and water

- Besides the security of state border the Army engineers provided help in works for road to access the location and build a fence for the camp
- Police ensured the security and control
- Establishment of temporary shelters

What should be the role and support provided by the national government institutions

- financial support and management of refugee camps
- food and non-food items
- communication and information sharing. Ensure involvement od LGs into decision making process related to integration and socialization of refugees/asylum seekers.

support provided by the international donors



- food, tends, furniture, baby and mother packs.
- provision of infrastructure for the refugee camp (provided water, electricity, hygiene conditions)
- covered costs for reconstruction of facilities of refugee centers.

What should be the role and support provided by the international donors?

- Provide more substantial financial support
- Supply with food and non-food items,
- equipment and infrastructure for Water Supply and Water Sanitation and for Solid Waste Management
- Health protection (medical supplies, surgical supplies, medicines etc.)
- Social care and education
