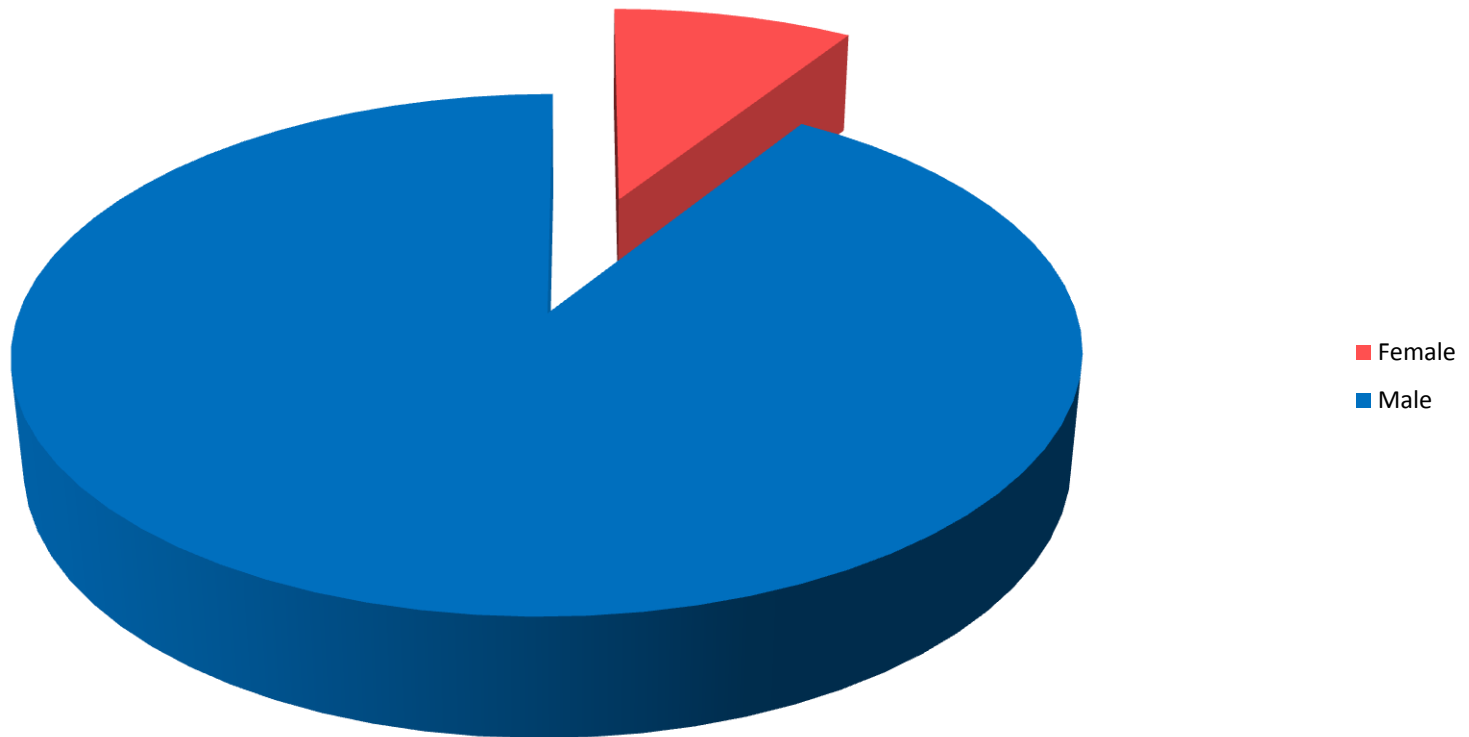

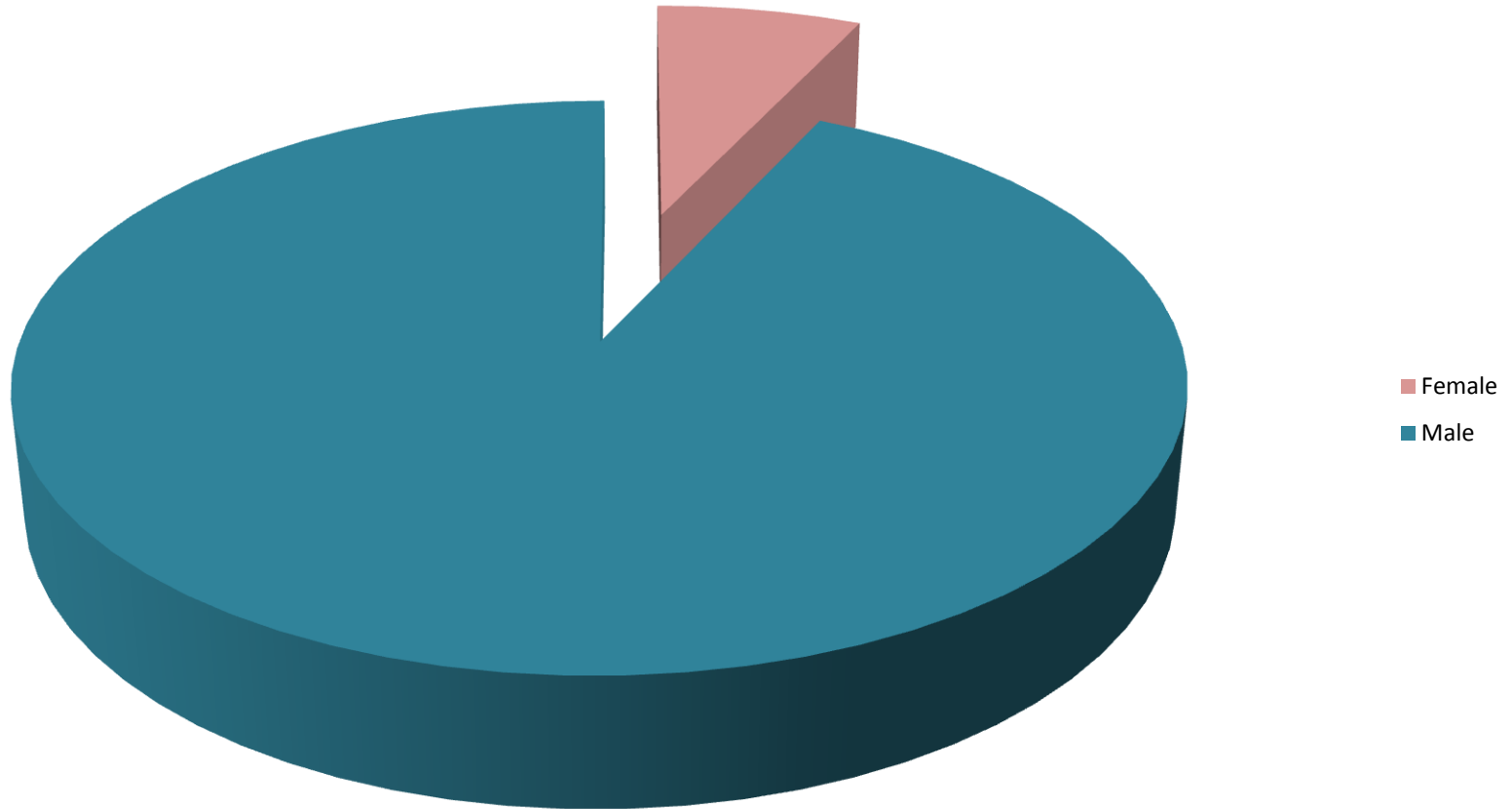

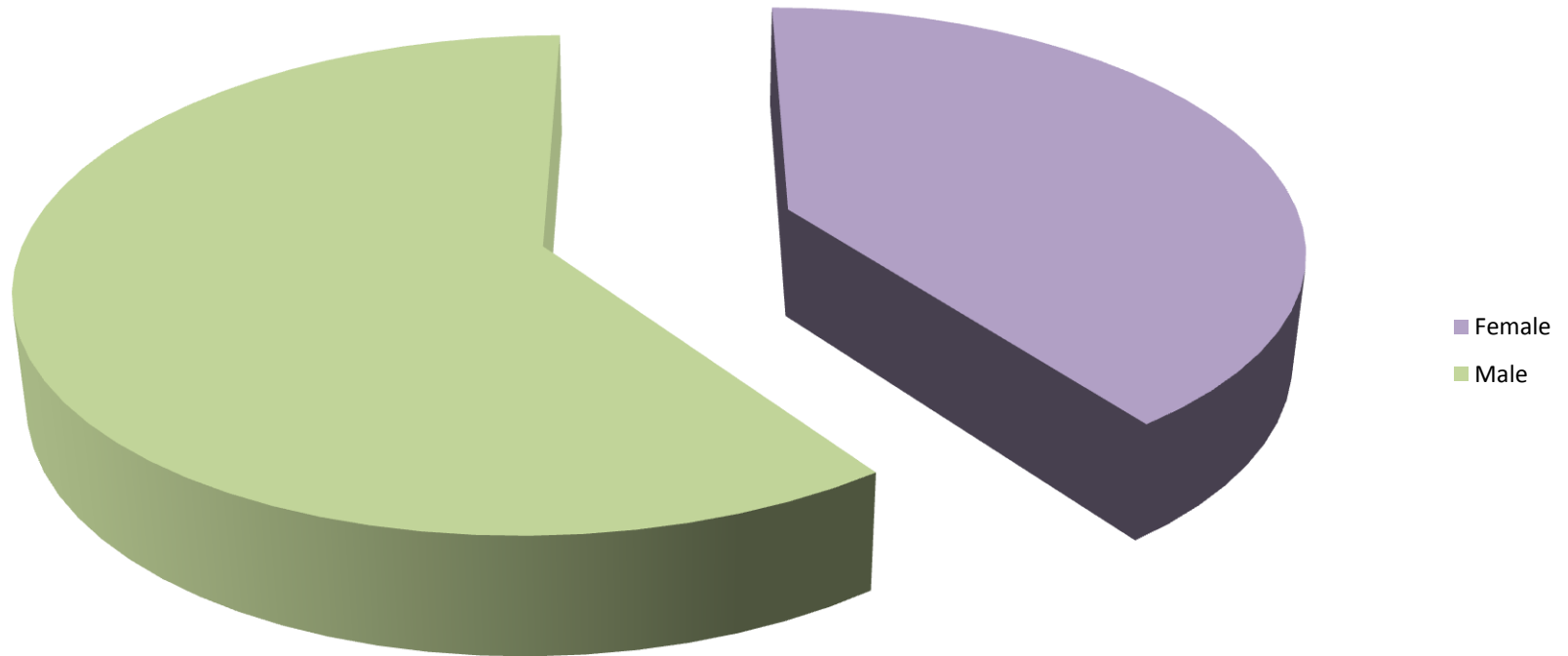
## Gender Structure of NALAS mayors in 2011



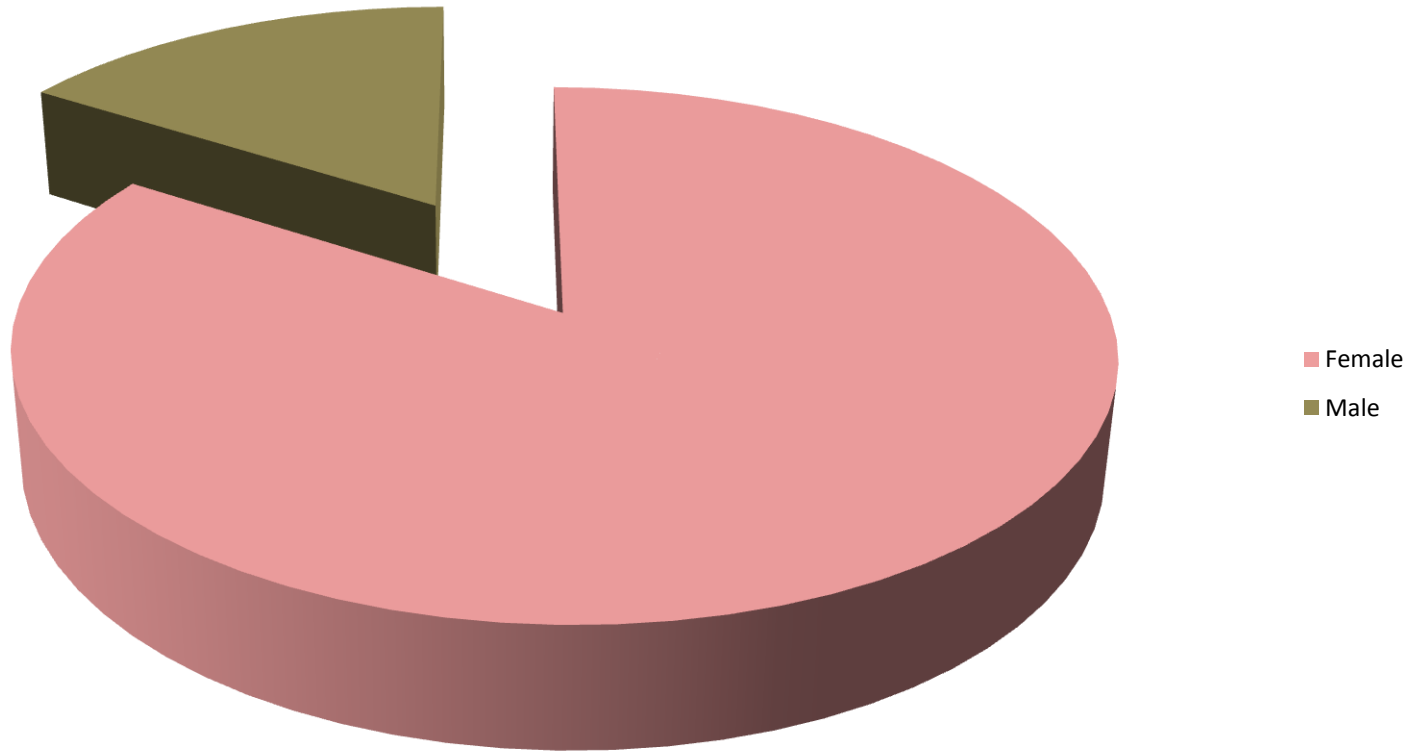
## Gender Structure of NALAS General Assembly 2013

## Fundamental principles :

- Equality of women and men is a fundamental right
- Multiple discrimination and disadvantage must be addressed
- Balanced participation of women and men in decision making is a pre-requisite of a democratic society
- Elimination of gender stereotypes is fundamental
- Integrating the gender perspective into all activities of local and regional government
- Properly resourced action plans and programmes
