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











TYPES OF BRIDGES

- MACRO-BRIDGES across borders both in terms of legal instruments and of activities: bridging states and their governments, kin-states and kin-minorities (11 cases + 8 CBC instruments)
- MESO-BRIDGES within states bridging institutions and people: between national and local governments and between governments and citizens (43 cases)
- MICRO-BRIDGES at grass-root level: bridging people both within and across states (44 cases)
- Bridges have both a horizontal (peer-to-peer) and a vertical dimension
- All types of bridges can be simultaneously functioning
- Total number of positive cases identified: 97

• Diversity management **OF** ... / **IN** ...

All involved parties need to be bound by:

- Political will for partnership and cooperation

- Engagement and accountability
